Logistic functions are used in logistic regression to model how the probability of an event may be affected by one or more explanatory variables: an example would be to have the model $y = \frac{1}{1 + e^{-x}}$, where x is the explanatory variable, and y are model parameters to be fitted, and e is the standard logistic function..
